SPOOKY EYEBALL CUPCAKE BOX



MATERIALS

CCX213A Cupcake Box
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Liner Brush

COLORS

CMM 2 - Stonewashed
CMM 101 - Fresh Heather
CMM 39 - Blue Green
CMM 69 - Orange Juice
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 14 - Gumdrop
CMM 16 - Chiffon

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start by painting the icing on the lid with 3 coats of Fresh Heather using a medium brush.
2. While that dries we will work on the base. For the stripes, use a liner brush to apply 3 coats of paint alternating between Gumdrop, Stonewashed, Fresh Heather, and Blue Green. We didn't do a pattern, just random colors of stripes. We did all the stripes for each color before moving on to the next color to make it easier
3. Paint the center of the dots on the lid with three coats of paint. We used Orange Juice, Blue Green, Gumdrop, and Fresh Heather.
4. When the color dried, we put a dot of Licorice in the center. To get an even dot, use the handle of your paint brush dipped in the paint and stamp it on.
5. Finally, we used a detail brush to add Chiffon "veins" around the whites of the eyes.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- Don't be too stressed about the eyes being perfect, we are going for cute and quirky
- The harder you push down on the brush, the thicker the line will be. So, on the veins keep the brush straight and don't press down to get the finest lines.
- Your stripes won't line up with the lines on the pottery perfectly, that's okay! It'll look great after firing.
