JEWEL TONED JOY OMBRE ORNAMENTS



MATERIALS

CCX3101 Value Ornament
Medium Brush

COLORS

CMM 2 - Stonewashed
CMM 45 - Indigo
CMM 83 - Perfectly Plum
CMM 25 - Safari
CMM 90 - Red Hot
CMM 42 - Cranberry Sauce
CMM 39 - Blue Green

Color Me Mine

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INSTRUCTIONS

These ornaments can be done in any colors. It's best to choose colors that will blend well together. For example: shades of the same color, or colors that are next to each other in a rainbow.

You'll need three colors for each ornament; a light, a medium, and a dark. Here are the colors we chose. They are listed from lightest to darkest:

Red Ornament - Safari, Red Hot, and Cranberry Sauce

Teal Ornament - Blue Green, Indigo, and Stonewashed

Plum Ornament - Indigo, Passionate Plum, and Stonewashed.

1. Start by painting the medium color around the middle 1/3 of the ornament. Use a medium brush and apply 2 fast layers.
2. While the medium color is still wet, use a medium brush to apply 2 fast layers of the light color to the top 1/3 of the ornament. Allow the light and medium color to overlap and mix.
3. Use a medium brush to apply two fast layers of the dark color to the bottom 1/3 of the ornament. Allow the dark and medium color to overlap and mix.
4. Add one more layer to each section, allowing the colors to overlap and mix where they meet.

TIPS

- By letting the colors overlap and mix, we will create a blend of the colors where they meet.
- It helps to apply the paint quickly so that the wet colors can blend together.

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
